

## 1st to 4th Grades

## Who can play?

BYSA Football will accept any players except 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> graders in the U32 school district (without a waiver from the Central Vermont team).

We will help to set up car pooling from local towns to make the traveling easier by connecting registered players with one another.

## Who do we play?

The Northern Vermont Youth Football League (NVYFL) is our association of 15 teams in the northern half of Vermont. Team geography

ranges from the Barre area in the south of the region to areas from Burlington to North Country west to east. Each team represents a specific geographic area, and is operated independently. The NVYFL is the governing body. Each team has representation on the board and the board works together to develop a schedule, rules and manage operation of the league.

# Registration

The registration dates will be May 26<sup>th</sup> and June 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm at the Aldrich Public Library. Coaches will be present and will discuss the expectations of the coaches, players and parents in this program. We welcome players and parents to attend and learn more about the program. We will present a sample of the equipment and uniform and be happy to discuss questions or concerns players or parents may have.

The registration fee will remain \$95.00 for the 2011 season. The fee **includes** the \$25 equipment deposit. Those registering after August 1<sup>st</sup> will pay **\$110**.

Please bring the COMPLETE registration package to one of the registration nights. Information about equipment pick-up dates will not be given until we have a complete registration packet.

## COMPLETE REGISTRATION PACKAGE:

1. Registration Form
2. Copy of the player's birth certificate (1<sup>st</sup> year players only)
3. Either the registration fee or a completed Fee Installment Form (found on the website).

Camp registration will be \$45 (\$40 for registered 2011 season players) which includes a Camp t-shirt. We encourage novice and experienced players entering 1<sup>st</sup> grade to 8<sup>th</sup> grade to participate in camp from ANY TOWN in central Vermont.

Coaches will distribute conditioning information to help players wishing to prepare for the 2011 football season. Many use this opportunity to try the sport. Campers are not required to be registered for the 2011 season to participate in camp. The Camp stations will be run by the coaches in our program. Take this opportunity to meet the coaches and try our sport and our program!

Camp will include numerous agility and football drill stations for all skill levels. Every day of the camp campers should bring cleats (for outdoor activities), sneakers (for indoor) and a water bottle.

Camp includes guest coaches and players from local high schools, universities and/or semi-professional teams. This is a completely noncontact camp. The focus is on speed, agility and conditioning.
